



# EGANS CREEK GREENWAY

## Rules for Special Events

*The Greenway is a nature preserve.*

***Please respect our natural resources by observing the following regulations:***

- In order to prevent scheduling conflicts and to ensure that the following rules are acknowledged, please notify the Parks and Recreation Department prior to conducting a group event in the Greenway.
- The park is open during daylight hours only.
- Stay on approved trails (see official trails map).
- Event coordinators are responsible for ensuring that the location or route is clear of wildlife prior to and during the event and for informing participants of the possible presence of native wildlife such as snakes, alligators and biting insects.
- No feeding or harassment of wildlife.
- No unauthorized motorized vehicles.
- Unapproved marking of trails and the removal or trimming of vegetation is prohibited. Approved markings may not occur more than 24 hours prior to an event and must be removed within 24 hours of event completion.
- Entering the water is prohibited.
- Installation of port-a-potties within Greenway boundaries is prohibited.
- No littering. Event coordinators are responsible for removing event-related trash from trails immediately following the event.
- No alcohol.
- No hazardous materials or fires.
- No loitering off trails or under bridges.
- If pets will be involved in the event, they must be leashed at all times, pet waste must be removed immediately, and pets are not permitted in the water.
