

# Address Numbers

To assist police, rescue, fire, and other public service agencies, and for the convenience of the public, each residential, commercial, or industrial structure visible from the public right-of-way is required to display a street number.

1. Numerals shall be attached to the front of the structure or shall be on both sides of the post supporting a mailbox at the street side of the property, shall be at least four (4) inches high for residential buildings, six (6) inches high for commercial buildings, 0.5 (half) inch wide, and shall be either of reflective material or in such color as to provide maximum contrast to the background.

2. Structures that are set back more than sixty (60) feet from the right-of-way or structures that are blocked from visual sight from the right-of-way by high or heavy vegetation, walls, or other structures shall display street numbers at the street entrance on a double-faced sign, monument or pole, which shall not be more than three (3) feet high and shall not be more than one (1) square foot in area.



## KEY POINTS

Address numbers must be in a visible location and contrast with their background.



Numbers must be at least four (4) inches in height for residential buildings and structures, and at least six (6) inches in height for commercial buildings and structures.
